BVI Forms Converter: Maintain existing usage, and generate FundsXML

From September 2009 BVI reports will only be accepted in FundsXML format. The Microsoft® Word and Microsoft® Excel forms previously used will no longer be supported. The established processes for recording data for BVI reports seem now to be obsolete.

COMIT BVI Forms Converter closes this gap and transforms existing BVI form data into FundsXML format.

The COMIT application 'BVI Forms Converter' offers a convenient opportunity to benefit from retaining your existing BVI report forms, and to meet the BVI requirements for data delivery in FundsXML at the same time.

The existing forms can still be used for data recording. COMIT BVI Forms Converter reads one or more completed forms and generates a single FundsXML file, including all input information which can be directly sent to BVI.

It is also possible to convert multiple forms to one FundsXML file at any time. The user can decide when and which data will be delivered to BVI. It is also possible to set up a partial data delivery on single fixed or multiple target dates.

COMIT BVI Forms Converter: how does it work?

Collect, transform and verify forms data

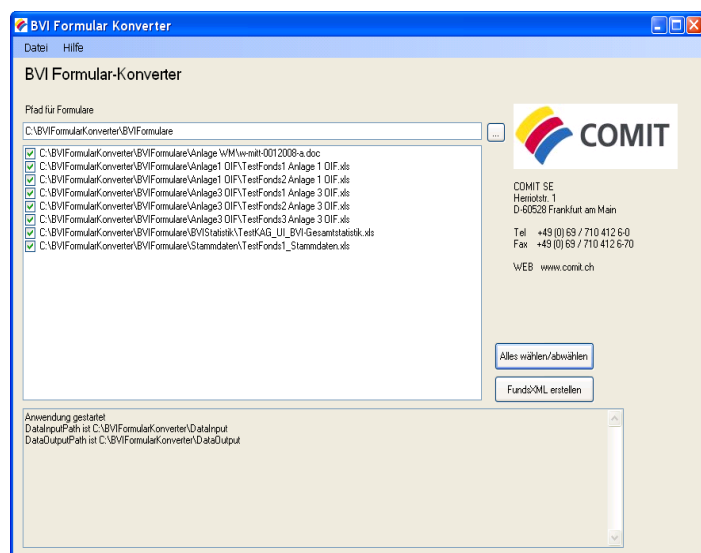
The core of the application produces and verifies a single FundsXML file from a wide variety of completed BVI forms. Multiple reports relevant to the reporting period can be processed at any time – the result of transformation is always a single FundsXML file.

Using the XML technology

One of the main benefits of XML and one of the reasons for BVI to adopt data delivery in the FundsXML format is the ease of data validation in the XML format. The FundsXML-Schema defines the format and the content of the delivered file which is the basis of the validation check. In this way the same verification can be executed via BVI Forms Converter, before the data is sent to BVI, as is presently done at BVI after the data is received.

Foresight: ready for new demands and requirements

COMIT has been actively involved in the ongoing development of FundsXML for many years and therefore is continuously up-to-date with its evolution. New BVI requirements and potential future FundsXML releases will be rapidly implemented by COMIT.
